

Fludroxycortide Tape

CUTTING GUIDE

Previously called
Haelan Tape

As a patient with an inflammatory skin condition, you have been prescribed Fludroxycortide Tape. The tape can be cut to size and placed directly onto your skin lesion. Try to minimise contact with healthy skin. The tape delivers a controlled, measured amount of

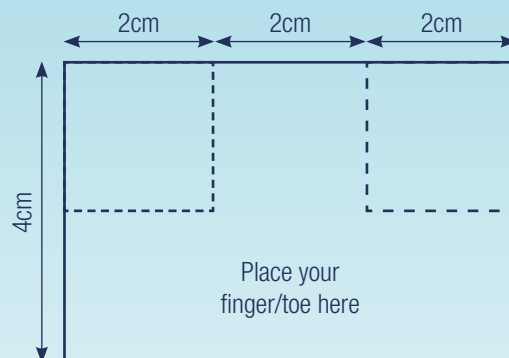
steroid over a 12-hour period. Use the cutting guides below to ensure the tape stays in place. Should you need a larger or smaller covering, simply cut the tape according to the area you need to use to cover.

GUIDE 1: FEATHERED EDGES

Feathering the edges with small diagonal cuts allows the tape to mold around the area and ensures easy movement of the joint.

GUIDE 2: KNEES AND ELBOWS

For rounded treatment areas diagonal cuts inwards from each corner are used.



GUIDE 3: FINGERS AND TOES

For fingers and toes cut a T shape from the tape to create an area that wraps around the digit.
